



ATDC membership application

The ATDC is the peak body representing and supporting community organisations, and the people they assist, to reduce alcohol, tobacco and other drug related harm for all Tasmanians. Our vision is a Tasmania without alcohol, tobacco or other drug related harm or discrimination.

Problematic use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs continues to be a major cause of harm in Tasmania, and is a significant driver of preventable death, disease and illness, psychological distress, unemployment, homelessness, police arrests and prison sentences.

As an independent not-for-profit organisation, the ATDC represents a broad range of alcohol, tobacco and other drug organisations. These organisations provide information and awareness, prevention and early intervention, harm-reduction and specialised treatment and recovery services and programs.

Working with all levels of government and the community, the ATDC plays a vital role in leading, collaborating and advocating for increased investment into treatment services, and population based initiatives that reduce the harms associated with problematic substance use across Tasmania.

The ATDC supports the sector by delivering training, networking and information sharing opportunities, as well as undertaking policy and advocacy projects with, and on behalf of our members. At all times our work is underpinned by a commitment to evidence-based practices and policies, lived experience participation, harm reduction, and partnerships and collaboration.

Benefits of membership

Members gain access to a range of services provided by the ATDC, as well as the opportunity to contribute to the development of the Tasmanian alcohol, tobacco and other drugs sector.

- **Inform sector development and policy:** Members can contribute to the ATDC's local and national policy submissions, contribute to the development of annual Tasmanian Government State Budget Priority Statements, and be involved in the co-design of sector reform planning and implementation initiatives relating to the Tasmanian alcohol, tobacco and other drugs sector

Organisational and Individual Members can also nominate for appointment to the ATDC Board of Governance.



Membership Categories

Full Membership - Voting

- Nominated representatives of non-government, not-for-profit organisations that are able to demonstrate an interest and involvement with the prevention and reduction of harms associated with alcohol, tobacco or other drug use
- People with lived experience, past or present, of alcohol, tobacco or other drug services in Tasmania (includes family members and/or carers)
- Other individuals committed to, and able to contribute to the purpose and objectives of the ATDC
- Life members, who have been individually acknowledged to have rendered outstanding service to the ATDC and/or the alcohol, tobacco and other drugs sector over a long period of time are provided with ongoing full membership. Life membership is granted at a General Meeting on the express recommendation of the ATDC Board of Governance.

Associate Membership - Non-Voting

- Individuals who are elected to government office, or organisations that do not qualify for full membership may apply for associate membership.

Membership fees

Organisational Membership fees are calculated on the organisation's alcohol, tobacco and other drug program/service annual gross turnover. Fees are payable per financial year, that being July 1 to June 30. For organisations joining partway through the year, pro-rata fees will be applied.
