## Lived Experience Advocate Service

### Advocate and organisation facing

**IN A NUTSHELL:** A Service that matches Lived Experience Advocates (LEAs) to organisations who request the lived experience voice

**GOAL:** To run an effective Service that connects the lived experience voice to the ATOD sector

**CHIEF RESPONSIBILITY:** Recruiting and supporting LEAs, coordinating service activities and supporting organisations to engage with the Service

#### KEY DELIVERABLES:

1. Maintain an effective Service
2. Delivery of skill development opportunities, such as the Course in Consumer Leadership
3. Advocacy & support for the LEAs to do their role

## ATDC Advocacy

### Government, community and media facing

**IN A NUTSHELL:** The ATDC continues to lobby for funding the independent lived experience organisation and embedding lived experience voices in policy, strategy and media discussions

**GOAL:** A funded independent lived experience organisation

**CHIEF RESPONSIBILITY:** Working with government and community leaders to mobilise support for the independent lived experience organisation and the importance of the lived experience voice at a policy/strategic level

#### KEY DELIVERABLES:

1. Active and visible advocacy
2. Increased activities for LEAs
3. Funding request for 2023-24 State Budget

## AOD Reform Project

### Member, government and advocate facing

**IN A NUTSHELL:** Produce the business case necessary to finalise the funding request for the independent lived experience organisation

**GOAL:** Deliver a compelling business case endorsed by people with lived experience, government and ATDC member organisations

**CHIEF RESPONSIBILITY:** Building the business case and the stakeholder relationships to secure an independent lived experience organisation

#### KEY DELIVERABLES:

1. The business case for the independent organisation
2. Evidence of broad sector-wide endorsement of the business case

## Lived Experience Project

### Advocate facing

**IN A NUTSHELL:** This role is responsible for coordinating opportunities for people with lived experience, including the development of the business case for the independent lived experience organisation

**GOAL:** Ensure people with lived experience have their voices heard and have been included in the work to establish the independent lived experience organisation

**CHIEF RESPONSIBILITY:** Ensuring engagement processes are meaningful and coordinating responses on behalf of a community of people with lived experience

#### KEY DELIVERABLES:

1. A pilot Community of Practice that delivers a campaign on an issue of importance
2. Delivery of presentations to the ATOD sector
3. A lived experience forum
